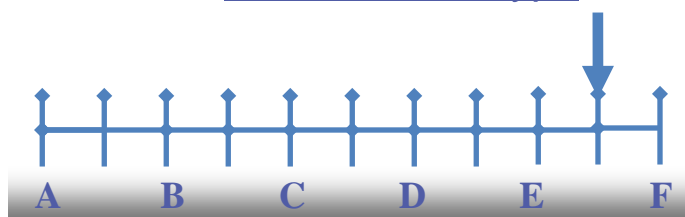

The Mental Health Center Serving Boulder and Broomfield Counties (MHCBBC) embeds staff that is fully integrated and functioning as part of primary care teams at Clinica Family Health Services, Inc. – People's Clinic in Boulder, CO. This includes full-time bilingual clinicians as well as a psychiatrist who is at the clinic approximately 10 hours/week. The clinical approach is Solution Focused Brief Therapy, when appropriate.

### Program Type

- Collaboration in a Fully Integrated System (Mental health embedded in a Federally Qualified Health Center). Behavioral health clinicians function similarly to Clinica staff by following Clinica procedure's and charting responsibilities.
- Direct Clinical Service, Consultation; Referrals
- Payor Mix: 25.08% CICP, 31.21 Medicaid, 4.67% Medicare, 1.68% private ins. and other, 34.73% Self Pay, 2.68% CHP+

### Operational Resources

- Clinica Family Health Services, Inc. provides the facility and related supports to ensure that access to the clients' primary health record is available.
- Clinica Family Health Services, Inc. and MHCBBC share responsibility for the supervision, technical resources and operational supplies to support the healthcare delivered by its integrated staff.
- MHCBBC provides laptop computers to their behavioral health staff and all charting is in the Clinica electronic medical record. Clinica provides additional on-site IT support and related access.
- All behavioral health staff has access to MHCBBC electronic records for service/referral coordination.

### Fiscal Resources

- Medicaid is not billed per Memorandum of Understanding set in place. Uninsured patients are billed per Clinica's policy. Private insurance billed when possible.
- All behavioral health encounters are submitted to each the Clinica billing system. A file is sent to FHB Partners for evaluation purposes and to count Medicaid contacts.
