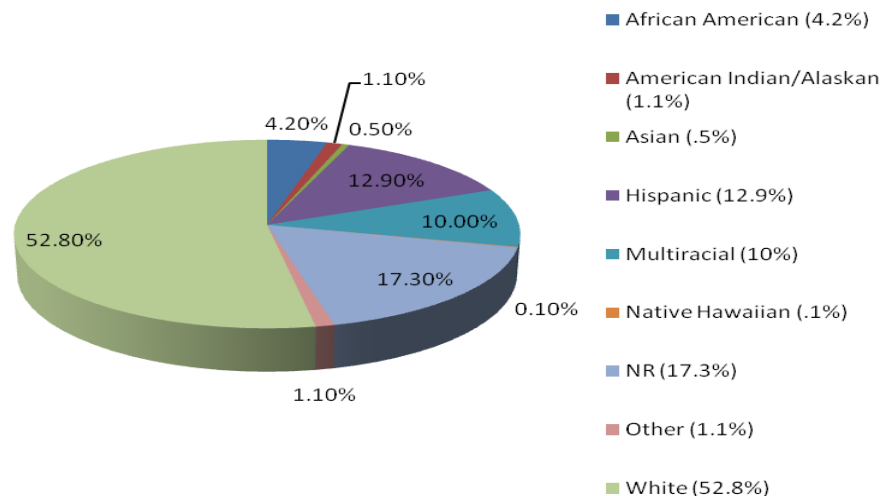


***Colorado Behavioral Healthcare Council
 Who Are We Serving?***

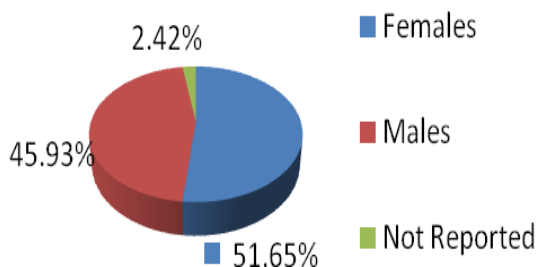
The Colorado Behavioral Healthcare Council membership is comprised of all 17 community mental health centers (CMHCs), two specialty clinics—Asian Pacific Development Center and Servicios de la Raza—and the 5 Behavioral Health Organizations (BHOs), which are the state’s Medicaid mental health managed care companies. CBHC member organizations contract with the State of Colorado and work together to provide comprehensive behavioral and psychiatric services to every region of the state.

- The statewide network of Community Mental Health Centers served **89,213 unduplicated** clients in 2008.

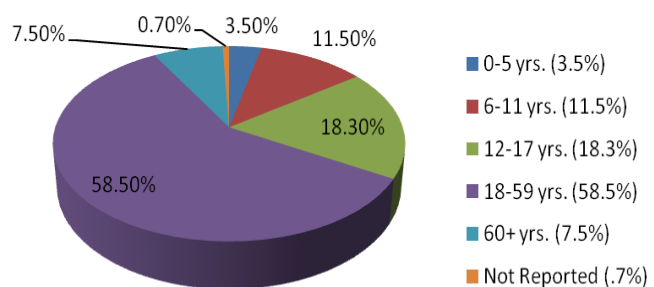
Diversity of Clients in 2008

CBHC membership provides mental health services to a diverse population across the state, including over 37,000 kids just last year.

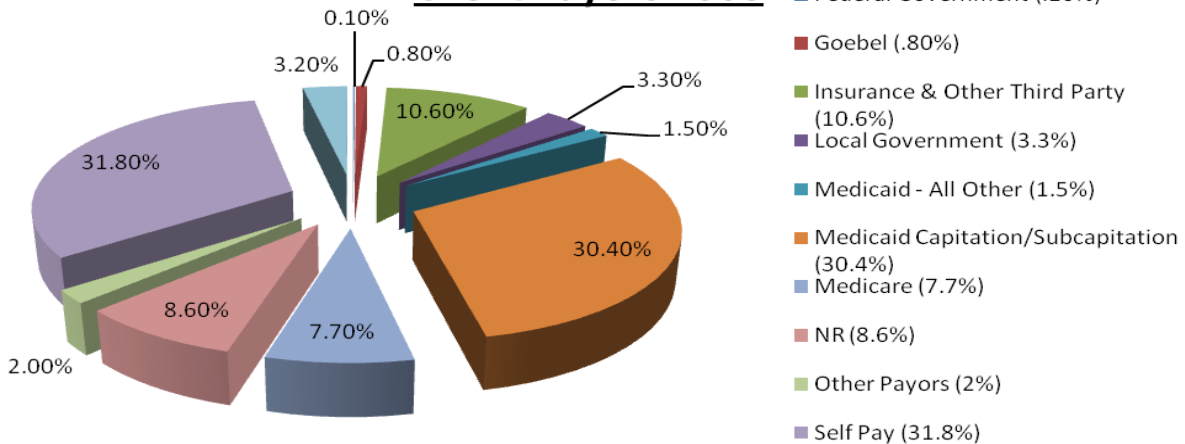

The services mix in 2008 demonstrates the wide variety of care provided by Colorado's CMHCs. The Case Management statistic exemplifies our commitment to client recovery that extends beyond the clinician/patient relationship, to include assisting people to obtain and coordinate a diverse range of community resources, tailored to individual needs.

The chart above shows the diverse payor sources being utilized by CMHC clients. Self pay includes people who have no insurance or are underinsured.

The chart to the right illustrates the revenues derived from this array of funding streams. With only 4.2% of revenues coming from private insurance, it is clear the CMHCs play an important partnering role with public funders to provide care to the under and uninsured.
