

## Restaurants Near the Capitol/Warwick

- **PhoNatic:** 229 E. Colfax (just across street from the capitol) – \$ – Vietnamese, great pho and noodle bowls – 10am-8pm, does not serve liquor
- **Bourbon Grill:** 571 E. Colfax - \$ - Simple take-out window preparing grilled chicken a variety of ways, plus sides like mac n cheese – 11am – 9pm
- **Shish Kebab Grill:** 1503 Grant St. (just across street from the capitol) – \$ – excellent, fresh family-operated Middle Eastern – 11 am-8:30 pm, does not serve liquor
- **Smiling Moose Deli:** 1710 Sherman – \$ – deli sandwiches/salads, burgers, breakfast burritos – 7 am-2 pm
- **Subway:** 1775 Sherman – \$ – the sub sandwiches you know and crave – 9am-6 pm
- **City o’ City:** 13<sup>th</sup> and Sherman (1 block south of capitol) – \$\$ – vegetarian – 12pm-12 am
- **Gattara:** 1776 Grant St. (inside Warwick) – \$\$ – pastas, pizzas – 6:30am-10 pm
- **Park & Co:** 439 E. 17<sup>th</sup> Ave. - \$\$ - Hip burger joint – does not accept reservations – 11am – 10pm
- **Steuben’s:** 523 E. 17<sup>th</sup> Ave. – \$\$ – modern diner food (fried chicken, meatloaf, etc.) – 11 am-10 pm
- **D-Bar:** 494 E. 19<sup>th</sup> Ave. – \$\$ – sandwiches, salads, burgers and more with fantastic fresh-baked cookies and cakes; owner is an award-winning pastry chef and host/judge on “Food Network Challenge” – **closed Tuesdays** but if you stick around through Wednesday they’re open 11:30-9 pm
- **Las Delicias:** 439 E. 19<sup>th</sup> Ave. – \$\$ – long-time local Mexican restaurant, classic Tex-Mex and Michoacan-style food – 8am-9 pm
- **La Loma:** 1801 Broadway – \$\$ – long-time family Mexican restaurant, known for its housemade tortillas and New Mexico-style green chile – 11am-9 pm
- **Brown Palace Hotel:** 17<sup>th</sup> & Broadway
  - Ship Tavern – \$\$\$ – classic American pub food – 11am-11pm
  - Churchill Bar – \$\$\$ – cigar bar – 2pm-11 pm
  - Palace Arms - \$\$\$\$ - old-school, high end, continental dining – 5pm-9:30 pm
- **Guard and Grace:** 1801 California St - \$\$\$ - Modern steakhouse serving chops, small plates & fine wines in an airy space with a raw bar & patio – 11am-2pm and 4pm-10pm
